**ROLL CALL:** Present: Mayor Daly, Trustees Bradstreet , Husk, Nolan and Piccola, and Attorney Williams.

**PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE**

**REGULAR MEETING**

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES:** Motion was made by Trustee Nolan, second by Trustee Bradstreet to approve the minutes from Oct. 3, 2011 as submitted. Vote, 4 ayes. CARRIED.

**APPROVAL OF ABSTRACT:** Motion was made by Trustee Bradstreet, second by Trustee Nolan to approve payment of Abstract #8, vouchers 354- 431 for \$100,735.30. Vote, 4 ayes. CARRIED.

**PRESENTATION: FINGERLAKES AMBULANCE:** Trustee Husk introduced Ken Kelly, General Manager, Bill Comella, Dir. of Operations and John Lester of Finger Lakes Ambulance. John Lester reviewed the year for Finger Lakes Ambulance in the Town and Village. Overall the average response time for the year was 4 minutes 39 seconds. They have a total of 12 ambulances with seven to nine of them on the road during the day. There were several positive comments and compliments from the public.

**TRUSTEE REPORTS**

**Trustee Bradstreet** reported that the Dollars for Scholars committee will be doing a little trail cleaning this weekend or next.

**Trustee Husk** moved to accept Mike Storto for membership into the Fire Department following completion of the appropriate training and a satisfactory physical examination. Second was made by Trustee Bradstreet . Vote, 4 ayes, CARRIED.

**Trustee Nolan** reported that the Watershed Council has passed their budget; our contribution of \$4005 will increase to \$4021.

**Trustee Piccola** reported that the sidewalks for the SRTS have been poured from West Foster to just past 327 Canandaigua; the stone foundation has been laid from there almost to the corner of Charlotte. One round of brush pickup has been completed. The Highway crew made a Kent St. water line repair. The two new signs for the Canal Park will run \$33.58 each. Motion was made by Trustee Piccola, second by Trustee Bradstreet to order the two new Canal Park signs from Wayne County highway department. Vote, 4 ayes. CARRIED.

**Attorney Williams** – no report.

**Mayor Daly** provided her usual written report, highlighting the Honor Flight reception held on November 9<sup>th</sup>.

**NEW/OLD BUSINESS:**

**DENISE JACKSON:** Denise asked that the Board re-visit the snow removal issue in the business district. Many of her clients are in wheelchairs and walkers. She not only removes the snow in front of her storefront but in front of her neighbors as well to accommodate those that park in front of those businesses. There are other structures in front of her storefront; ie. bench, garbage can, etc.

**FAIRGROUND REGULATIONS:** Mayor Daly asked if the Board had reviewed the packet from Code Enforcement Officer Wooden. Trustee Piccola suggested that the Fair President be sent a copy of the regulations. It looks as though it has been overlooked for quite some time. The regulations are part of Chapter 200-23 of the Village code.

**MINOLTA BIZHUB360:** The Clerk Treasurer asked the Board to consider upgrading the copier being leased and used in the office of the Village Clerk. Motion was made by Trustee Bradstreet, second by Trustee Husk to move \$2110.00 from contingency A1990.4 to A1325.4 Treasurer Contractual to close out the lease on the BizHub350 and to order the color replacement off state contract. Vote, 4 ayes. CARRIED.

**VIENNA STREET PARKING PROBLEM:** Two residents from Vienna Street asked if there had been a decision about the parking issue on Vienna Street, namely parking on the west side of the intersection at Throop and Vienna too closely to the intersection. The Board promised to look into it by checking the Traffic Code.

**EXECUTIVE SESSION:** Motion was made by Trustee Nolan, second by Trustee Husk for a matter of litigation and contractual at 8:10 p.m. Vote, 4 ayes. CARRIED.

**PUBLIC SESSION:** Motion was made by Trustee Nolan, second by Trustee Bradstreet to move back into public session at 9:00 pm with no action having taken place in executive session. Vote, 4 ayes. CARRIED.

**ADJOURNMENT:** Motion by Trustee Bradstreet, second by Trustee Husk to adjourn at 9:00 p.m.. Vote, 4 ayes. CARRIED.
