Bid recommendation for Shilling/Goldsmith Rds. Intersection reconstruction: On April 30, bids were opened from contractors who wish to work on the Shilling/Goldsmith Roads intersection reconstruction project. At the board meeting, Supervisor Lyon noted that all bids came in substantially higher than had been planned. At this time, it will only be possible to do Part A of the reconstruction. In addition, it will be necessary to borrow \$46,000 from the town's surplus funds account. Board members agreed that now is the time to do the work since the town is working on the Shilling/Lusk intersection and the Wayne County Water and Sewer Authority is laying the water pipes in the area. Detours have also been planned for the affected roads. Part A costs include clearing and grubbing, earthwork, installing gravel, extending culvert, turf restoration, and importing fill to the site, etc.
