Meeting called to order by Wm. W. Edgerton chairman and Board declared in order for business

Wm. W. Edgerton Supr presented his report which was examined and found correct his report shows a balance of \$17.61 on hand in Poor and Contingent Fund and \$233.70 in Dog Fun.

A. G. Wigglesworth Overseer of Poor presented his report with vouchers accompanying same which upon examination were found to be correct with a balance of \$280.83.

Salem W. Sweezey Highway Commissioner presented his report which upon examination was accepted and ordered placed on file - Report shows a balance of \$105.97 in the hands of the Commissioner.

Mr. H. P. Knowles Commander of G. A. R. Post No. 193 presented his report showing expenditure of Soldier Relief Fund for the past year which was accepted and ordered placed on file.

Motion made and seconded that One Hundred and fifty dollars be raised by tax for Soldiers Relief for the ensuing year - Carried

It was then recommended that the sum of Seven Hundred Dollars be appropriated and raised by tax at the next Tax Levy for support of poor for the ensuing year.

It was also recommended that Two Hundred Dollars be taken form the Dog Fund and placed in Contingent Fund

The Town Clerk was instructed to prepare and post notices of above appropriations in five conspicuous places and to procure 600 ballots to be used at coming election in voting for said appropriations.

It was also moved and carried that the sum of Two Hundred Dollars be taken from the Dog Fund and placed in the Contingent Fund.
